Heart of Education Awards Program

The Heart of Education Awards program is now in its second year, with nominations being accepted through Jan. 31, 2017. Please visit theheartofeducation.org and nominate a teacher who has gone above and beyond in the classroom. To be eligible, licensed teachers must be full-time and have completed at least three consecutive school years of teaching in CCSD. A nomination can come from a student, alumnus, parent, colleague, community leader or anyone who is not related to the teacher and who is familiar with their work. The online recommendation must be 200 or fewer words describing how the teacher deserves to be recognized for going above and beyond.
